2. P&C Structure

The John Butler Primary College P&C consists of the following Executive Committee members. The Office Bearers are the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The Executive Committee consists of these Office Bearers, the Principal and at least 3 financial members.

EXECUTIVE MEMBERS

PRESIDENT: Is the vital link between parents and college administration; developing a nurturing relationship between the both. The main role of the President is to effectively run meetings and be the face of the P&C.

VICE PRESIDENT: In the event that the President is absent at any General or Executive Committee meetings, the Vice President can chair the meeting. The Vice President is ideally placed to act as a liaison person between the P&C and WACSSO.

SECRETARY: The Secretary is responsible for:

- Posting notice of meetings
- Assisting the chairperson to draw up an agenda
- Recording of minutes of a meeting
- Dealing with correspondence
- Maintaining membership records
- Observing legal formalities
- Being a signatory to accounts.

TREASURER: The Treasurer's role is to:

- Maintain procedures for handling the Associations money
- Issuing receipts
- Bank all money received
- Prepare and present a report for every General Meeting
- Prepare books for audit
- Have overall responsibility for all P&C accounts including all sub-committees.

PRINCIPAL: The Principal is an *ex officio* member of the Executive Committee and has the same rights and responsibilities as any other Executive member.

SUB-COMMITTEES: Are formed to perform specific tasks on behalf of the P&C. They may elect a convener, secretary and / or treasurer. Decisions of the sub-committees are subject to the approval of the full P&C.

WACSSO REPRESENTATIVE: The Western Australian Council of State School Organisations Inc. (WACSSO) is the peak body representing parents of public school children in Western Australia.

3. JOHN BUTLER PRIMARY COLLEGE P&C VISION

The Inaugural John Butler Primary College P&C's vision is to:

- Support the College's vision & purpose, most importantly in achieving the best possible educational outcomes for our children.
- Uplift & enrich the students' educational experience.
- Set the standard for our P&C's culture going forward.
- Create a community which we can be proud of in our college environment, with a focus on inclusivity.
- Where possible, support our college's families in their endeavors to provide the best educational start for their children.
- Provide families with access to and a deeper understanding of the College's educational goals & strategies, by running educational forums & other initiatives from time to time.
- Assist in developing a strong families / administration mutual understanding.
- Encourage the participation of all college families; meeting them at their level of comfort.

4. BECOMING A P&C FINANCIAL MEMBER

Anyone over the age of 18 is able to join the P&C Association. Membership is on an individual basis with no provision for family membership.

If you wish to join the P&C Association you may do so at any General Meeting during the year, provided that the membership fee of \$1.00 is paid at the time of joining.

If you do not become a Financial Member of the Association you have no voting rights.

All renewal subscriptions become payable at the Annual General Meeting of the Association.

5. P&C CONSTITUTION

The Constitution currently used by the incorporated P&C Associations was developed in conjunction with Crown Law solicitors, the Minister for Education, the Education Department's legal advisers and WACSSO. It is important that all members of the P&C Association are aware of the implications and requirements of the Constitution.
