2026 VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

Dear Parents and Caregivers

Financial support provided by parents plays a significant role in extending the school's capacity to add value to the learning experiences of our students. This support is provided in the form of:

- 1. Voluntary Contributions
- 2. Charges for Extra Cost Optional Components
- 3. Items for Personal Use

The John Butler Primary College Board has endorsed this schedule of contributions and charges for 2026 which aligns with the *School Education Regulations 2000* as part of the *School Education Act 1999*.

1. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Voluntary Contributions are used towards the cost of resources used by students in the educational program and represent an important revenue source. While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our program in all curricular areas is maximised when all families contribute.

The total voluntary contribution amount sought per child is \$60, with discounts available for families with multiple children.

Important Notes - please read carefully:

- The charges vary from year level to year level depending on the nature and range of activities undertaken. The estimated costs indicated represent the <u>maximum</u> amounts that a parent/carer should anticipate being charged throughout the coming school year. Very few students, if any, participate in the full range of activities available. For example, Instrumental Music and PEAC involve very small numbers of students.
- Charges must be paid prior to the planned activity. If personal circumstances result in payment difficulties, please contact the principal to make alternative arrangements or access available support.

3. ITEMS PERSONAL FOR USE

These are items that a student requires to fully participate in the learning activities. The list of items will vary by student and includes those:

- Required by all students and used in lessons, e.g. stationery items, calculator, etc.
- Recommended for all students, e.g. art shirt, tissues, etc.
- Required for selected students, e.g. musical instruments.

Some items, such as calculators and headphones, may be used in successive years. Other items, such as pens, pencils, glue, may need to be replenished throughout the year. A list of recommended items, informally termed the "booklist", is provided for each child.

Parents may purchase the items from any retailer or use the school's nominated supplier, Campion Education, who have provided a very competitive rate.
